For optimal results:

- Print in colour on good quality paper
- Select your printer's highest quality settings
- Print on both sides of the paper, flip on short edge

Preparing your card:

- Once printed, cut along the dotted line
- Then fold in the middle
- Tip: Allow a little time for the ink to dry before writing on the paper
